_____ **Field trip #1: Tour of new Rapid City Water Treatment facility and Cleghorn Springs Fish Hatchery**
Description: Tour will start at the new Rapid City Water Treatment facility, which is accessed by taking the first right as you start up Cleghorn Canyon (about 1/4 mile west of Canyon Lake. From there we will walk down to the Raw Water facility that is located just downstream from the mouth of Cleghorn Canyon and just south of SD44. From there we will walk down to the Cleghorn Springs Fish Hatchery.
