**Cheyenne Bridge Out (1906, page 72)**

News from the Oral neighborhood, as reported in it column, the Oral Out crop described the predicament of the folks down that way when high water damaged the bridge: "the 'injured' bridge over the Cheyenne caused considerable inconvenience. Some had to leave their teams across the river, and get across on the railroad bridge and be taken home by neighbors." April, 1906, was the month in which the famous San Francisco earthquake and fire occurred, and the Star carried a fairly long front page story on the tragedy.
