Bear Butte Creek Flood Gets Action From Case

Washington, May 4 —(AP)—A review by army engineers of possible improvements along Bear Butte creek in western South Dakota was ordered today by the house flood control committee.

Rep. Case (R-S.D.) who requested the survey, said it was authorized under the program for improvement of the Cheyenne river and its tributaries. The committee previously called for a similar study of Rapid creek in the Black Hills.

Case said he made the request because a severe Bear Butte flood was reported to him by telegram. Overflow from the creek endangers the highway between Sturgis and Fort Meade.
